Dear Teamsters Local 731 Member:

We are pleased to announce the participation of Teamsters Local Union No. 731 in the 2019 "Building Bridges to Health" Fairs. Teamsters Local 731 Benefit Funds and the Midwest Employee Benefit Funds Coalition, Inc., ("MEBFC") have agreed once again, to partner in a venture that will afford each Local Union member and their eligible dependents, age 18 and older, greater accessibility and convenience regarding the procurement of annual flu shots and healthcare screenings at no cost to you.

Participants are eliqible to receive a health assessment, comprehensive blood test, blood pressure screening, flu shot, basic hearing screening, nutrition information, access to a Pharmacist as well as other onsite healthcare professionals to answer questions. Women over the age of 40 will also receive thyroid testing. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to update your Tetanus vaccine, which now offers whooping cough protection. And if you are at risk for pneumonia and meet the clinical criteria, you can get that vaccine at this year's health fair as well. This year, we are again providing basic carotid artery tests.

Because we have limited appointments available for the carotid artery testing, if you are interested in having this test, kindly make that appointment first, with Stroke Detection Plus, and then use that date to schedule your blood test through Interactive Health. You may refer to the enclosed Stroke Detection Plus flyer for more information.

These tests and procedures are all available at no cost to you and your eligible dependents, age 18 and older. The tests you choose to have performed are not meant to replace your physician, but are meant to improve communication with your Physician at your next appointment.

This program is completely confidential and is administered by Interactive Health, an independent service provider. To schedule your blood test, visit www.myinteractivehealth.com or call (800) 840-6100. If requested, our Sponsor Code is ZW9DY; you will also be asked for the name of our Fund (Teamsters Local 731) and your Group and ID numbers, which you can locate on your Blue Cross Blue Shield (BCBS) card. You will also be required to present your BCBS card when you arrive for your appointment.

Those who participate in the blood test will be entered in a raffle to win one of five \$50.00 gift cards

Teamsters Local 731 will be hosting the Health Fair on September 14th at Operating Engineers Local 150, located at 6200 Joliet Road, Countryside, IL.

At the September 14th event, we will have staff members from the Teamsters Local 731 Benefit Fund Office in attendance to answer any questions you may have regarding your benefits. A representative from Interactive Health will also be in attendance to discuss and explain the Local 731 Wellness Program and how to utilize this valuable benefit. Don't forget, each member and spouse who participates in the blood test is also taking the first step in participating in the Local 731 Wellness Program and will qualify for the 2020 \$400.00 Wellness Incentive.

How to Schedule Your Onsite Health Evaluation

- 1. Register online at myinteractivehealth.com. First time website users can register using sponsor code Z W 9 D Y.
- Once registered, click the "Schedule Your Health Evaluation" box at the top of the page. Select your appointment location, date and time and complete your health assessment. You will be asked your Union Name and Number or Trust Fund Name and Number (Teamsters Local 731).
- **3. Health Plan Participants:** Enter your Blue Cross Blue Shield (BCBS) ID Number and Group Number. *Please bring your BCBS card to your appointment.*
- **4. Non-Plan Participants:** The fee of \$120 or \$160 is due at the time of service. Cash, personal check, MasterCard and Visa are accepted.
- You may also schedule your appointment by calling Interactive Health at (800) 840-6100 and using sponsor code Z W 9 D Y.

You will need to *Fast* before your appointment

Please fast for 12 hours before your test. Drink plenty of plain water – no food or other beverages. If you are diabetic, pregnant, on medication, or have a medical condition that will prevent you from fasting 12 hours, please follow your doctor's instructions regarding fasting.







Building Bridges to Health – 2019

You are invited to participate in a comprehensive Health Fair sponsored by your Trust Fund. In addition to a comprehensive, 36-panel blood test, the following services/providers will be available:

- > **A1c** blood tests for diabetics
- ➤ **Flu shots** (for adults over age 18) The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends that everyone 6 months old and older should receive a flu vaccine. Every flu season is different, and influenza infection can affect people differently.
- Ask the Pharmacist Pharmacists are available to answer questions about drug interactions, how or when to take medication, what impact do vitamins or supplements have with other medications, what side effects you should expect and other questions that you may have.
- Ask the Dentist Dental providers will be available from 9:00 am until 12 noon to answer your questions. Information and resources will also be available during the entire fair.
- ➤ **Nutritionist** Learn about your BMI and ask questions about food pairings and how to read labels. This year be sure to bring a healthy recipe with you for the **Healthy Recipe Contest!** Every recipe gets a gift, but the healthiest recipe (selected each week by the nutritionist) will win a food basket!
- Basic hearing screening
- ➤ Carotid Artery screening Limited appointments available! If you are interested in this test, schedule this first and then call to make your bloodwork appointment. See the Stroke Detection flyer for more information about registering for this screening.


