

2024 TEAMSTERS LOCAL UNION NO. 731

Trade School Scholarship Application

The Local 731 Scholarship Program, established in 2007 by the Local Union's Executive Board and Fund Trustees, provides scholarships to high school seniors planning to attend college, university, community college or trade school, and current college attendees with at least (1) full academic year remaining prior to graduation.

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, aptitude, personal qualifications, and financial need by the Scholarship Selection Committee.

Applicants must comply with the following eligibility and application criteria.

Each applicant must.

- 1. Be the dependent child or grandchild of an active IBT Local Union No. 731 member in good standing, which is a participant in one of the following health plans on the date application is submitted to the Fund:
 - Health and Welfare of the Excavating, Grading and Asphalt Craft Local No. 731
 - Local No. 731, I.B. of T., Health and Welfare Fund
- 2. Have a plan/goal for education beyond high school.
- 3. Submit SAT or ACT score report. (For high school seniors only.)
- 4. Plan to attend or are currently enrolled at an accredited college/community college.
- 5. Submit an official, current transcript bearing the school's seal. The transcript submitted should be through the end of first semester of the current school year. <u>E-mail</u> your school counselor for assistance in obtaining the official transcript. You may submit an unofficial transcript with the application and have the counselor send the official one when available.
- 6. Submit a complete copy of the applicant's processed application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). <u>If you are unable to print the completed report, please submit the student's confirmation email from FAFSA showing the following: Student Name, Submission Date, Date Release Number and Estimated Student Aid Index (SAI).</u>

The applicant cannot be an immediate family member of Teamsters Local No. 731 Union and Benefit Fund Office employees or an owner or employee of a Contributing Employer who does not perform bargaining unit work.

All applicants will be **notified by April 15, 2024**, if they are or are not selected for a Scholarship. Remember that even if you are not selected this year, you may apply again next year. Several applicants have been awarded a scholarship that were not successful on their first or even second attempt.

Completed applications must be received by 4:30 P.M. on <u>Friday, March 1, 2024</u>.
